Ordered Tri-M chords, \$ shortage on Tri-M t-shirts-didn't sell all that were ordered

Incoming Freshman Night May 11th- table of Tri-M students to represent music program and answer questions, Marti will be there on behalf of Boosters

Orchestra- excellent job at State Assessments

Graduation- June 8th-Wind Ensemble and Jr Drummers 2:30 graduation, early dismissal (bus 12:45 home by 5:00) wear Performance Wear- Nancy will get water/snacks

Orchestra Concert- low attendance, extra late night for student pickups

Chorus Director's Report: (Joey Shortall): not here tonight

Treasurer's Report (Nancy Spencer):

Should go into next year with roughly \$10,000 which will be the minimum needed to pay up front for Performance Wear.

\$1800 could be added if all candy sales are paid in full. Note- 26 students owe for boxes of candy- how can we facilitate getting this money? Kathy will send a note to office concerning this. Situation is a great improvement on last year, but still not ideal.

No more student accounts.

Nancy will get checks for scholarships to the guidance office. (Scholarships will be announced at Senior Awards Banquet on May 25th- 2 -\$400 scholarships.)

OLD BUSINESS:

Uniform Buyback- extended discussion to try to figure out a plan- will try this out on a limited basis this year- \$15 buyback and then resell for \$25

We do need to make sure we get "borrowed" Performance Wear back

We will work on updating By Laws over the summer
