Approval of December Minutes (Kathy, 2nd-Mr. Dennis)

Instrumental Music Director's Report (Ms. Krawczyk):

The concert was fantastic-so great to be live in person. It is invaluable for a musician to have an audience. The videos have been posted to Schoology.

Some of the ordered music was delivered today, still a lot to come.

The Scholarship Concert will be march 3rd. We are hopeful that it will be live!

Assessments will not be off campus this year. Chamber and Wind Ensemble will record 2 pieces and then the BCPS Music Dept. will send two professionals to "critically assess" and work with the groups.

Jazz band is on hold (COVID/after-school activities).

There has been new guidance-that still needs some clarifications about the amount of time that music can be played/sung in class (50 minutes). Orchestra is still fine at the 90 minutes. Continuing to use PPE and seat separation to help protect from super-charged air. In big room, circulation- will follow protocols.

Chorus Director's Report (Mr. Dennis):

Apologies for the google form link on the concert program (to the Boosters) not working for last concert-will definitely work in future!

Chorus-we made some videos for YouTube for Morning Announcements, also on Schoology under Chorus Resources. I was able to out all the classes together into the videos-very happy with how it turned out!

Prepping for virtual, deciding on Concert music-could prepare individually if needed, but hoping we are live.

School has ordered the new risers and a new desk-waiting for that. Still a few more instruments to come in from the percussion order.

Needed: some sort of storage for the new instruments-maybe a cabinet, maybe a shelf with bins-thinking through that...

LOVED the concert-also, saw great improvement between 1st and 2nd concerts.

We need to start gathering for gift basket for Spring Concert Raffle- we have several gift cards including Greg's Driving school, Valerie will make a mosaic, reach out to Menchey for donations as well as to some of the smaller music shops. Melissa has the actual raffle tickets. We can do pre-sales (incentive to sell) to students.
