Eastern Technical Music Boosters Meeting Minutes (Approved)

March 7, 2022

Call to order at 6:35 pm

Approval of December Minutes (Kathy, 2nd-Mr. Dennis)

Treasurer's Report (Melissa Williams): See attached Treasurer's Report:

We received \$1,345.00 in donations at the Scholarship Concert-are still waiting on at least 2 more checks.

Pizza John's -\$152.95 received from the restaurant night. Check was lost/cancelled/resent- but will go back into account.

Still following up with Sweet Frog on their lost check.

Pizza was provided for the students who stayed through to help set up for the concert.

Instrumental Music Director's Report (Ms. Krawczyk):

Last week was an incredibly busy week!

BCPS Music Office was putting together the All County Music Concerts and needed everything very quickly, very last minute thrown together- had 2 weeks to nominate primary Juniors and Seniors (4 nominated 2 alternates). Then a meeting for all directors to put together the groups. Tuesday rehearsals, seating auditions by video. Ended up with 4 orchestras, 4 wind ensemble.

Also-at same time trying to put together Solo Ensemble groups- but then deadline move to April-so now maybe more people will participate.

Cultural Coalescence- March 24/25th Chamber Orchestra will perform World Music.

Towson University is having an All-Honor Orchestra day (like the band one in December) and I wanted to send a few students. It is \$30 per student, and right now we have three students interested in participating. Could Boosters pay for their fees?

Working on Spring Concert-students will pick the music.

Chorus Director's Report (Mr. Dennis):

Has also gone through the same process for All County Concert. The nomination process was unusual to say the least and while he is excited to have one student going (tenor), is disappointed with the process and is going to try to advocate to see if there is anything else he can do.

Solo Ensemble-will hopefully have more interest.

Risers might be here by next concert, still waiting for 1 or 2 more of the ordered percussion instruments.

PPE/masks now optional.

Was very happy with the concert-best one yet! They were very well-prepared. Now watching back videos.

Spoke about the drama club production of Grease-and helping to get word out.

President's Report (Valerie Thaler):

Concert program- only saw 1 of the groups listings-discussion about seeing what was wrong. The program is posted on Schoology.

Robo call about concert was VERY successful, loved the student announcers during the concert and the student donation collectors!

Question- are their music class subs? Answer- not really, would be rare. Other activities are done on days with subs, although in the past there have been time where students were able to conduct and lead rehearsal.

Discussion about being able to take music classes seniors year (AP classes, internships, etc., in constant competition), health will be come a full yr class, often need to get classes done over summer at CCBC in order to keep taking music. Need to really advocate with guidance in order to make that happen.

AP Theory Class- never have enough interest- and if -then you would lose them from the music ensembles. Potential audio technology class on the horizon. Also wanted a marching band- but just don't have the numbers to make that work.

TRI-M (Ms. Krawczyk read Carter's Report):

18 new students will be inducted at March 18th in-school induction. Still collecting aluminum can tabs for the Ronald McDonald House until mid-April. There is a parent who may talk to Tri-M about her families' experience at Ronald McDonald House.

From Ms. K- This years has had really great Tri-M leadership that has really stepped up and made things happen!
